SUMMARY

The Budget and Finance Committee recommends that the City Council approve the proposed FY 1988/89 expenditures for the Stockton Boulevard Business Improvement Area.

BACKGROUND

The formation of the Stockton Boulevard Business Improvement Area was approved in 1987 by the City Council. A special fee is levied, in addition to the City's Business Operations Tax, on all businesses within the defined area to be expended for the following purposes per City Code Section 23.812:

- (a) The general promotion of retail trade activities in the Area.
- (b) The promotion of public events which are to take place on or in public places in the Area.
- (c) Decoration of any public place in the Area.
- (d) Furnishing of music in any public place in the Area.

Since establishment of the Area, the City has contracted with the Stockton Boulevard Merchants and Property Owners Association to expend the monies collected as authorized annually by the City Council.

FINANCIAL DATA

Staff has reviewed the proposed expenditures for FY 1988/89 (Exhibit I) and concluded that the expenditures are within the scope authorized by City Code Section 23.812.



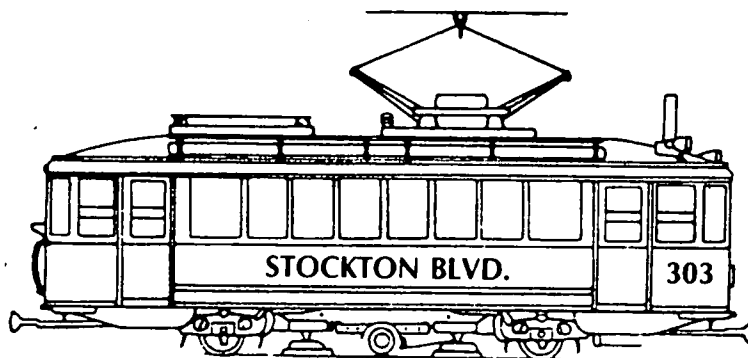


