

ORDINANCE NO. 815, FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 744, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED July 22 1937, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF CANNON, FIREWORKS OR ANY EXPLOSIVE SUBSTANCE IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, EXCEPT IN CONNECTION WITH PUBLIC DISPLAYS OR CELEBRATIONS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND/OR CITY MANAGER AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 74, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 11, 1922, AND ORDINANCE NO. 519, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 16, 1931.", BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED 3 $\frac{1}{2}$.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 744, Fourth Series, passed July 22 1937, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 3 $\frac{1}{2}$.

SECTION 3 $\frac{1}{2}$. Permission may be given by the Council for the use of firearms or fireworks as herein named on special occasions such as Chinese New Year, days picked for special notice during the Sacramento Golden Empire Centennial celebration. This permission may be given upon the recommendation of the City Manager acting by and with the advice of the Chief of Police, and given upon terms and conditions contained in the said recommendation.
