AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 4155, 4334 & 4406 FOURTH SERIES, TO AMEND SECTIONS 25.176 AND 25.183(b), TO CHANGE 25.182(d) TO 25.182(e) AND TO ADD A NEW 25.182(d) OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR CONTROL OF VISITOR PERMITS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1

Sec. 25.176 Visitor Permits is hereby amended to read:

The Traffic Engineer is authorized upon application to issue visitor permits to residents and owners of residential properties that are located within a residential permit parking area for use of bona fide transient visitors therein. Such a visitor permit shall have all the rights and privileges of a regular permit, except as provided in Sections 25.182 and 25.183. The requirements governing the manner in which persons shall qualify for visitor permits in each residential permit parking area shall be established by resolution of the City Council. The Traffic Engineer shall recommend appropriate requirements in each area.

SECTION 2

Sec. 25.182(d) Penalty Provisions is hereby added to read:

It shall be an infraction and a violation of this article to use, or allow to be used, a visitor permit for commuter parking. Use of a visitor permit for commuter parking shall mean use of a visitor permit more than three (3) times in a three (3) month period more than two (2) city blocks from the address for which it is issued. Use of a visitor permit for commuter parking shall constitute an infraction and a violation of this article both by the person to whom the visitor permit was issued and by the registered owner of the vehicle upon which the visitor permit is displayed. The fine for use of a visitor permit for commuter parking shall be as set by the judicial council.

SECTION 3

Sec. 25.182(e) Penalty Provisions is hereby amended to read:

It shall be unlawful and a violation of this article for a person to copy, produce or otherwise bring into existence a facsimile or counterfeit parking permit in order to evade parking regulations applicable in a residential permit parking area. Upon conviction thereof, a person shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or be imprisoned for a period not exceeding six (6) months or both. (Ord.
