

ORDINANCE NO. 536, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 41 AND REPEALING SECTION 39 OF ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED DECEMBER 22, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1st, 1921."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 41 of Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed December 22, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:-

SECTION 41. Dance Halls - For every person, firm or corporation conducting, managing or carrying on a public dance hall where dances are held one, two or three nights per week, \$12.00 per quarter when floor area does not exceed 3,000 sq. ft.; \$15.00 per quarter when floor area is more than 3,000 sq. ft. and less than 7,000 sq. ft.; \$30.00 per quarter when floor area exceeds 7,000 sq. ft.

Where dances are held four nights or more, \$25.00 per quarter when floor area does not exceed 3,000 sq. ft. ; \$35.00 per quarter when floor area is more than 3,000 sq. ft. and less than 7,000 sq. ft.; \$50.00 per quarter when floor area exceeds 7,000 sq. ft.

For the purpose of this ordinance, a 'dance hall' is defined to be any place where the business of holding or conducting of public dances is regularly carried on.

SECTION 2. Section 39 of Ordinance No. 18, 4th Series, passed December 22, 1921, is hereby repealed.
