ELECTRIC, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,188,312**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

The construction funded by this contract will affect Sump 28 near the Southwest corner of Freeport Blvd. and Meadow View Road (District 7) (see enclosed map).

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution, based on the City's current MBE/WBE policy which:


- Transfers fund from Sump 43/Colonial Village project (PN:WA66) to Sump 28 Electrical Upgrade (PN:WC73).
- Accepts the responsive low bid from Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric in the amount of \$1,188,312 and awards the contract.

**SUMMARY**

Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on May 7, 1997; Clyde G. Steagall Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric was the lowest responsive bidder.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The site currently contains two pump stations, three electrical services and outdated electrical equipment. The proposed project consists of combining two pump stations into one by consolidating facilities into one electrical service and one control building, upgrading electrical service and control equipment to current standards, providing generator back-up power, and raising all electrical equipment to above the 100-year flood level.

On May 7, 1997, eight bids were received, the four lowest of which were:

Staff recommends the award to Clyde G. Steagall, dba Mid Valley Electric because the first three low bidders are non-responsive with their Good Faith Efforts. (See Exhibit A).

## ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301 (b) and 15302 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Based on the bid of \$1,188,312.00, the revised estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, construction, inspection, and contingencies is \$1,450,000. The project currently has an unobligated balance of \$749,747. Additional funding of \$650,000 will be required to complete this project. It is recommended that funds for this project be transferred from the Sump 43/Colonial Village project (737-500-WA66-4820), which has an unobligated balance of \$1,541,883 as of May 12, 1997. Re-evaluation of the overall scope of the Sump 43/Colonial Village project has resulted in a significant decrease in the total estimated project cost.

## **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

This action is in conformance with City Code sections, 58.03.304, & 58.03.301, which provides that the City Council may award competitively bid contracts to the lowest responsible bidder and "advertising for bidding" requirements respectively.

## **MBE/WBE**

This project included participation goals of 10.75% MBE and 9.5% WBE as required by Resolution 93-619, relating to MBE/WBE participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1993. Award of the project is contingent upon the responsive low bidder either meeting these project MBE/WBE participation goals or making documented good faith efforts toward meeting the project goals. The responsive low bidder, Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric, participation goals were 13.21% MBE and 11.18% WBE. The current MBE/WBE participation totals to-date for the Department of Utilities are 9.50% and 6.79% respectively.

The three low bidders are determined by City Staff to be non-responsive with their Good Faith Efforts. Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric exceeded the City MBE/WBE goals. Thus, Clyde G. Steagall, Inc., dba Mid-Valley Electric became the qualified lowest bidder.

Plans and specifications were sent to nine (9) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with the outreach to MBE/WBE contractors.

Other outreach efforts to MBE/WBE for this project included:

- Advertisement of the project on the City of Sacramento Construction Project Bid Line (916) 392-4758.
- Free access to review the project plans and specifications at the City of Sacramento, Architecture & Engineering Division Plan room at 927 10th Street.
- Provide notice of this project to three (3) minority chambers of commerce and three (3) minority and women community organizations directly involved with the outreach to MBE/WBEs.





This letter is your formal notification that Rutherford & Smith Construction, Inc. wishes to protest the City of Sacramento's position to reject our bid and award Sump 28 Electrical Upgrade PN:WC73 to the fourth lowest bidder, Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric. We complied with the City's newly adopted Ordinance No. 97-018 dated March 25, 1997 which does not require certified mailing nor faxed solicitations. (Exhibit A) Therefore, we feel our bid was incorrectly rejected and request an opportunity to present our position.

We were informed by Renee Graves of the Department of Utilities that our bid was rejected on the grounds that we did not comply with the M/WBE requirement to send each initial solicitation via certified mail or fax, therefore not making an effort to *reach* anyone. (Exhibit B) At the time we were preparing our M/WBE solicitation list several changes in the status of M/WBE programs in general and the City's in particular occurred. One such change was the City of Sacramento's implementation of a revised version of M/WBE compliance requirements, Ordinance No. 97-018, which went into effect April 1, 1997. The ordinance, however, did not mention certified mailing/fax requirements leading us to believe that the previous mailing procedure was acceptable. (Exhibit A, Item (3)) In most legal settings, disposition in the U.S. Post Office is proof of delivery.

Another change was the Department of Utilities' decision to include certified mailing/fax requirements in their bid documents for Sump 28 Electrical Upgrade PN:WC73 even though Ordinance No 97-018 did not require it. On page twelve of the M/WBE Requirements for Sump 28 Electrical Upgrade, when referring to solicitations, the Department of Utilities notes that "Failure to submit the verification required (certified mail/fax log) herein *may be* grounds for rejecting the bid." (Exhibit C) Since the newly passed ordinance did not require certified mail or fax verification, and the Department of Utilities request was *discretionary*, we chose to continue regular mailing followed up by phone contact to verify solicitation receipt and answer any questions regarding the bid project.

A check of our past Good Faith Efforts, as well as this one, would reveal we continue to contact M/WBE enterprises until we have a *firm commitment* to bid or not to bid. Rarely are we fortunate enough to reach or receive a commitment on the first try. But we continue to contact solicited M/WBE enterprises hoping for a decision. When they complain that being low doesn't get them the job, we explain that we, too, have to be

low. We encourage them to bid more than one contractor, thus, making them feel their efforts are worthwhile.

However, it has come to our attention that some General Contractors make only one follow-up phone call whether or not they receive any kind of commitment; whether or not they actually reach someone. This neither satisfies Ordinance 97-018, Item (4) nor is it in keeping with *spirit* of the "outreach program." Making one effort at a phone call and reaching no one isn't really much of an effort. We make extra phone calls and offer support and advice to M/WBE business on how to successfully make a transition into commercial construction and ultimately we are punished for not certifying our mail. Personal contact should account for something. Personal contact where efforts are made to encourage small businesses and answer questions regarding the relationship between generals and subcontracts and suppliers should bear more weight than it is given.

We do more than most contractors to satisfy Good Faith Efforts and convince M/WBE enterprises to bid. In addition to personal contact, you will note from our mailed solicitations that we contacted thirty-five M/WBE enterprises covering nine subcontractor/supplier specialties with a total possible contract value of \$761,713, over 69% of our bid. Neither the first or third low bidders came close to our coverage. Nor was their follow up comparable to ours.

Our position is that we *are* in compliance with both the legal application and intent of the City of Sacramento's outreach program, in particular the solicitation for bids requirements for which we were rejected. Additionally, we more than met the goals referred to in Item (9) of Ordinance No. 97-018 states, "The bidder's efforts to obtain MBE and WBE participation could reasonably be expected to produce a level of participation sufficient to meet the goals established for the contract." (Exhibit A) A review of our total M/WBE Good Faith Efforts package will substantiate our efforts to meet and exceed the established goals. We feel we were unfairly rejected and request reconsideration of our bid.

In closing we would like to point out that Rutherford & Smith Construction, Inc. has a history of complying with the City of Sacramento's M/WBE programs. More importantly, we have a reputation for encouraging M/WBEs to bid us and take the plunge into commercial construction. Isn't that the point of the "outreach" program.

**ORDINANCE NO. 97-018**

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF MAR 25 1997

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 58 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 58.08.802, RELATING TO MBE/WBE REQUIREMENTS AND ADDING CHAPTER 58.10, RELATING TO BID PROTEST PROCEDURES; AND DECLARING THE ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:**

**SECTION 1.**

Section 58.08.802 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

58.08.802 MBE/WBE efforts required of responsible bidder.

The specifications or request for proposal for any contract for a public project to be awarded by the city council may set goals relating to participation in the contract by MBEs and WBEs. No bidder on said contract shall be considered a responsible bidder unless the bidder either meets the MBE and WBE participation goals established for the contract or, if one or both goals are not met, made a good faith effort prior to the time bids are opened to meet such unmet goal or goals by performing all of the following actions:

- (1) The bidder attended a MBE/WBE program meeting held by the City to inform bidders of the minority and women's business enterprise program requirements within ninety days prior to the date that bids are opened.
- (2) The bidder identified and selected specific items of the project to be performed by MBEs and/or WBEs to provide an opportunity for participation by those enterprises. The total dollar value of those items

identified and selected by the bidder shall exceed or meet the goal or goals established for the contract but not met by the bidder.

- (3) The bidder requested, in writing, subcontract and supply proposals from MBEs and/or WBEs not less than 10 calendar days prior to the opening of bids. If the bidder does not meet the contract's MBE participation goal, for each item of the project identified and selected pursuant to action (2), above, the bidder shall request proposals from a minimum of three or one-third, whichever is greater, of the certified MBEs listed for each such item's category of work in the City's MBE/WBE directory; provided that if the City's directory lists fewer than three certified MBEs for any such item's category of work, the bidder shall request proposals from all of the certified MBEs listed for such category. If the bidder does not meet the contract's WBE participation goal, for each item of the project identified and selected pursuant to action (2), above, the bidder shall request proposals from a minimum of three or one-third, whichever is greater, of the certified WBEs listed for each such item's category of work in the City's MBE/WBE directory; provided that if the City's directory lists fewer than three certified WBEs for any such item's category of work, the bidder shall request proposals from all of the certified WBEs listed for such category. Bidders shall use the most recent MBE/WBE directory that is available on the date that the City advertises for bids on the project, including any updates to such directory that are included in the project specifications issued for the contract. The project specifications shall advise bidders how to obtain copies of and/or access to the City's most recent MBE/WBE directory.
- (4) The bidder followed up initial solicitations of interest by contacting the MBEs and WBEs solicited pursuant to action (3), above, to determine with certainty whether the enterprises were interested in performing specific items of the project.
- (5) Upon request, the bidder provided MBEs and WBEs with information about the plans, specifications, and requirements for the selected subcontracting or material supply work.
- (6) The bidder requested assistance from one or more of the following organizations: minority and women community organizations; minority and women contractor groups; local, state, or federal minority and women business assistance offices; or other organizations that provide

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assistance in the recruitment and placement of MBEs or WBEs, if any are available.

- (7) The bidder did not unreasonably reject the low bid from a MBE or WBE. The City shall provide a bidder who rejected a low bid from a MBE or WBE with an opportunity to explain the bidder's reasons for doing so, before the City determines whether the bidder's rejection of the low bid was unreasonable.
- (8) Upon request, the bidder advised and made efforts to assist interested MBEs and WBEs in obtaining bonds, lines of credit, or insurance required by the City or the contractor.
- (9) The bidder's efforts to obtain MBE and WBE participation could reasonably be expected to produce a level of participation sufficient to meet the goals established for the contract.

The bidder shall demonstrate compliance with actions (1) through (9), above, by completing the MBE/WBE Good Faith Effort Worksheet included in the project specifications issued for the contract. All MBEs and WBEs utilized by the bidder to meet the goals established for the contract must be City-certified MBEs and WBEs at the time bids are opened.

## SECTION 2.

Chapter 58.10 is hereby added to the Sacramento City Code to read as follows:

I'm here today because our bid of \$1,099,000 for Sump 28 was set aside for a more costly proposal of \$1,188,312 - \$89,312 more of the tax payers money.

The M/WBE committee reviewing the bids decided we did not fullfil our commitment to contact M/WBE business. **WE DID**. If someone had found the time to review our whole Good Faith Effort package, they would have found the proof they were looking for. We did infact meet the requirements set forth in Ordinance 97-018 AND the specifications.

**THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE:**

- 1. Attend a M/WBE meeting withing 90 days of bid opening. **We did.**
- 2. Select items for M/WBE participation totaling at least 20% of the bid. **We did.**

We designated 70% for subs/suppliers, \$761,713 of our \$1,099,000 bid; 20% required would only have been \$220,569.

We received M/WBE bids ranging from \$560 to \$735,613 (Nitta Construction and Central Sierra Electric). We used 3 M/WBE bidders: **Biondi Paving \$25,000 Nitta Const \$560 Sundburg Fence \$9349**

**The City is very clear about choosing the lowest bidder for their projects. To meet that requirement, we can only consider low bidders no matter who they are.**

- 3. Request in writing sub/supplier proposals not less than 10 days prior to bid opening; select specified percentages of M/WBEs; use the City's most recent directory.

City specs for Sump 28 added to the City's ordinance a "may be rejected" clause. In essence, if we didn't certify mail or fax our invitations, our bid **might** be rejected.

**This was not a will be BUT a may be**, clearly a criteria that would be used on contractors who did not perform an adequate Good Faith Effort. Ours was more than adequate. We have a history of complying with Good Faith Effort requirements, actively soliciting M/WBE businesses, and setting up extensive documentation to prove it.

We solicited 35 M/WBE companies by mail. We reconfirmed 33 by phone; 2 did not respond to our numerous phone messages.

**16 M/WBE companies responded** by faxing or mailing the invitation back with a note, OR faxed us a bid. Copies of those responses were included in our Good Faith Effort package which was reviewed by the City's committee. AND I have them here with me today. I don't know why the committe chose to ignore this proof. They just did. I apprised them of this information at our Bid Protest meeting, but they still chose to ignore it or did not take the time to review it. Despite the proof in their hands, they continued to stand by their contention that we did not mail our invitations.

- 4. The bidder followed up initial solicitation...**to determine with certainty** whether the enterprises were interested...

While some contractors make only one call, we always continue to call until we have a definite response. These calls are recorded on our M/WBE contact log and I showed copies of our long distance phone bill to the committee. Still, they rejected our bid.



5. Upon request, supply MWBEs with information about the plans, specs, etc. **We did.**  
Our contact log shows we faxed information to M/WBEs (Carefree Greens).  
We faxed take off lists to suppliers (General Supply).  
M/WBEs came into our office to inspect the plans & specs (Westmont Construction).

6. Requested assistance from one or more organizations: **We did.**  
We contacted 9 of the resources suggested by the City requesting either a list of their members; that they post our ad in a public place; or run our ad in their publication.

7. Not unreasonably reject a low bid. **We never reject low bids. We can't afford to.**

8. Offer advice/assistance for bonds, lines of credit, insurance. **We always offer any assistance requested.**

9. The bidder's efforts to obtain M/WBE participation could reasonably be expected to produce a level of participation sufficient to meet the goals established for the contract.

**Reiterate** Mailed 35 solicitations for 9 categories of work.  
Opened 70% of the project - 50% more than the City required.  
We were in constant contact with M/WBE businesses by phone, fax, or mail.  
Provided assistance when requested.

**We complied and were rejected for a bid \$89,312 more than ours.**

We complied with the legal application and the intent of the City's outreach program. Our rejection was unwarranted. Had someone found the time to review our whole package, they would have discovered all the evidence they needed to prove we did indeed mail our solicitations, and that we met or exceeded the Good Faith Efforts requirements.

**The M/WBE committee's oversight should not cost the City of Sacramento tax payers an additional \$89,312.**

**Nor should it cost us this job.**

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The site currently contains two pump stations, three electrical services and outdated electrical equipment. The proposed project consists of combining two pump stations into one by consolidating facilities into one electrical service and one control building, upgrading electrical service and control equipment to current standards, providing generator back-up power, and raising all electrical equipment to above the 100-year flood level.

On May 7, 1997, eight bids were received, the three lowest of which were:

Staff recommends the award to Clyde G. Steagall, dba Mid Valley Electric because the first two low bidders are non-responsive with their Good Faith Efforts. (See Attachment 1).

## ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301 (b) and 15302 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Based on the bid of \$1,188,312.00, the revised estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, construction, inspection, and contingencies is \$1,450,000. The project currently has an unobligated balance of \$749,747. Additional funding of \$650,000 will be required to complete this project. It is recommended that funds for this project be transferred from the Sump 43/Colonial Village project (737-500-WA66-4820), which has an unobligated balance of \$1,541,883 as of May 12, 1997. Re-evaluation of the overall scope of the Sump 43/Colonial Village project has resulted in a significant decrease in the total estimated project cost.

## **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

This action is in conformance with City Code sections, 58.03.304, & 58.03.301, which provides that the City Council may award competitively bid contracts to the lowest responsible bidder and "advertising for bidding" requirements respectively.

## **MBE/WBE**

This project included participation goals of 10.75% MBE and 9.5% WBE as required by Resolution 93-619, relating to MBE/WBE participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1993. Award of the project is contingent upon the responsive low bidder either meeting these project MBE/WBE participation goals or making documented good faith efforts toward meeting the project goals. The responsive low bidder, Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric, participation goals were 13.21% MBE and 11.18% WBE. The current MBE/WBE participation totals to-date for the Department of Utilities are 9.50% and 6.79% respectively.

The first two low bidders are determined by City Staff to be non-responsive with their Good Faith Efforts. Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric exceeded the City MBE/WBE goals. After applying price preference of \$25,000, Clyde G. Steagall, Inc. dba Mid Valley Electric became the qualified lowest bidder. (See Attachment 1).

Plans and specifications were sent to nine (9) plan-rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with the outreach to MBE/WBE contractors.



