

ORDINANCE NO. 688 , FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE AN ELECTRIC POWER HOIST FOR RAISING GRAVEL IN OPEN MARKET WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento an electric power hoist for raising gravel without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of accepting an offer whereby the City may purchase for \$700.00 equipment which costs \$1,250 new and upon which there has been practically no wear.
