SUBJECT: Traffic Signal Installation - Sutterville Road and 21st Street
(PN:SC56) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install new traffic signals at the intersection of Sutterville Road and 21st Street. The installation will replace the existing pedestrian warning flashers and provide better traffic flow in the area. It will also improve pedestrian safety for individuals needing access to Sacramento City College.

On January 10, 1989, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on January 31, 1989. The bids received were:

May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M&M Electric	\$54,044
Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, Inc.	\$55,455
Challenge Electric	\$61,248
J.K. Hayes, Inc.	\$63,935
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$69,222

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$55,000. The estimated project completion date is August 1, 1989.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$77,900. The current budget is \$80,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds (209). The funds available for this project amount to \$66,900, as of January 31, 1989.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

There are no policy considerations associated with this item.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. These are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with the MBE/WBE construction organizations. There were seven (7) plan holders for this project, none of whom were certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M&M Electric in the amount of \$54,044, and award the contract.
