SUBJECT: Approval of Consultant and Professional Services Master Agreement for  
Materials Testing Services - Raney Geotechnical

SUMMARY

Adoption of a resolution approving a Consultant and Professional Services Master Agreement for Materials Testing Services with Raney Geotechnical is recommended.

BACKGROUND

In January 1989 the City Council approved the use of the Master Consultant Agreement System for Materials Testing Services on Public Works projects. Under this system, consultants who can perform the desired testing will have an individual Consultant and Professional Services Master Agreement approved by the City Council and on file with the City Clerk and Public Works showing the price schedule and insurance coverage but not a dollar amount. Consultants are selected for each project on a rotation basis unless a special need arises. As a materials testing requirement arises for a project, the Director of Public Works will approve an amendment to the agreement with the particular consultant selected, naming the project, the scope of work to be performed and a "not-to-exceed" dollar amount. Large projects, requiring more than \$10,000 of materials testing, would still require an individual agreement for each project.

On July 24, 1990 the City Council adopted a resolution approving the Master Consultant Agreement System for Fiscal Year 1990/91 and authorizing the City Manager and the Director of Public Works to expend not more than \$150,000 during Fiscal Year 1990/91 for routine materials testing services. It is recommended that Raney Geotechnical be added to the list of six materials testing firms currently used on Public Works projects.

FINANCIAL DATA

There is no direct financial impact on the City. The funds to be expended for materials testing services have been appropriated in the Capital Improvement Program (Object Code 4802) and the operating budget (Line Items 4250, 4252, and 4258) depending upon the nature of the individual projects.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is in conformance with Council policy established in January 1989 approving the Master Agreement System for Material Testing Services.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Of the six materials testing firms providing services on Public Works construction projects, one is a minority/women-owned business enterprise and an Equal Opportunity Employer.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Consultant and Professional Services Master Agreement for Materials Testing Services with Raney Geotechnical.

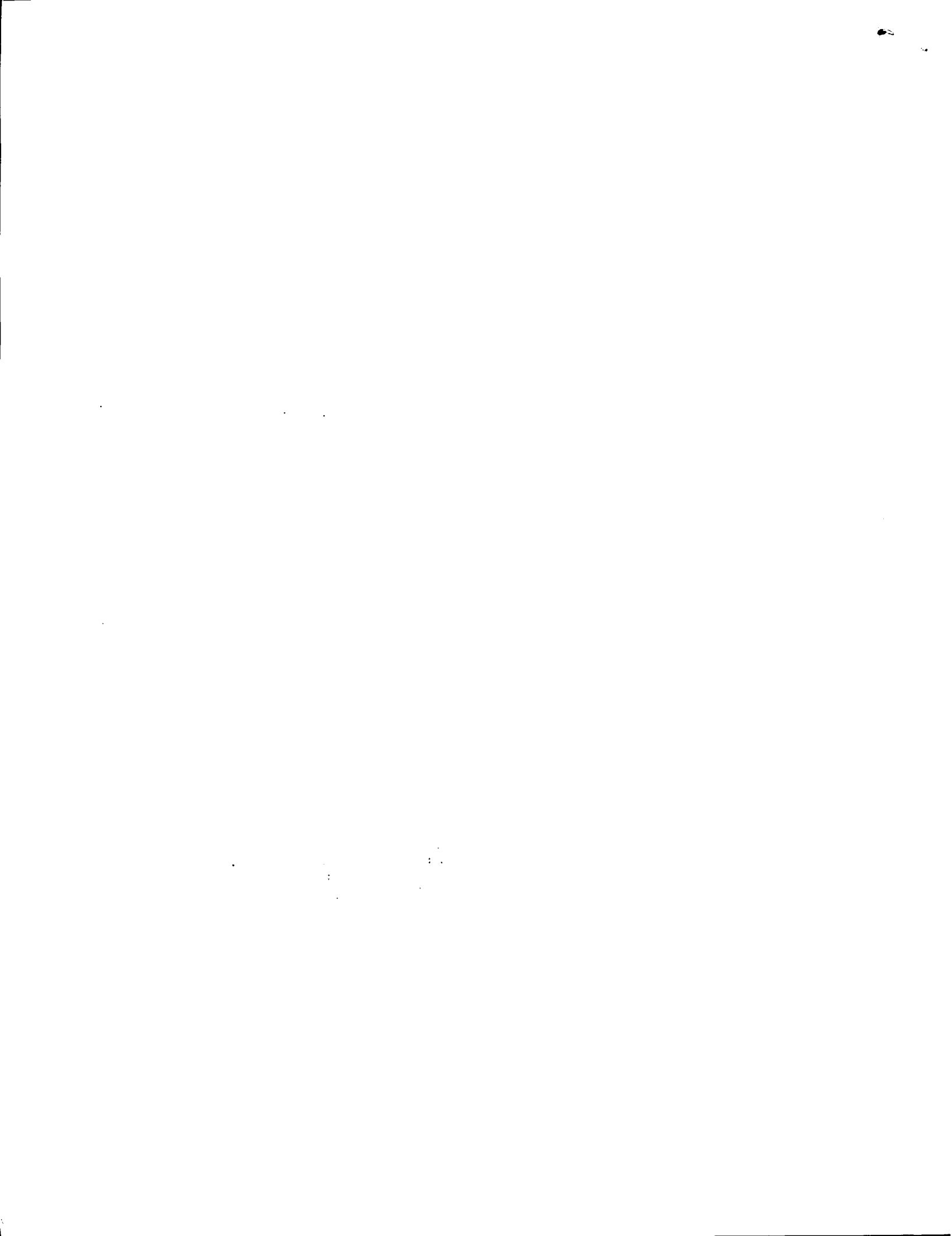
