

MW-5

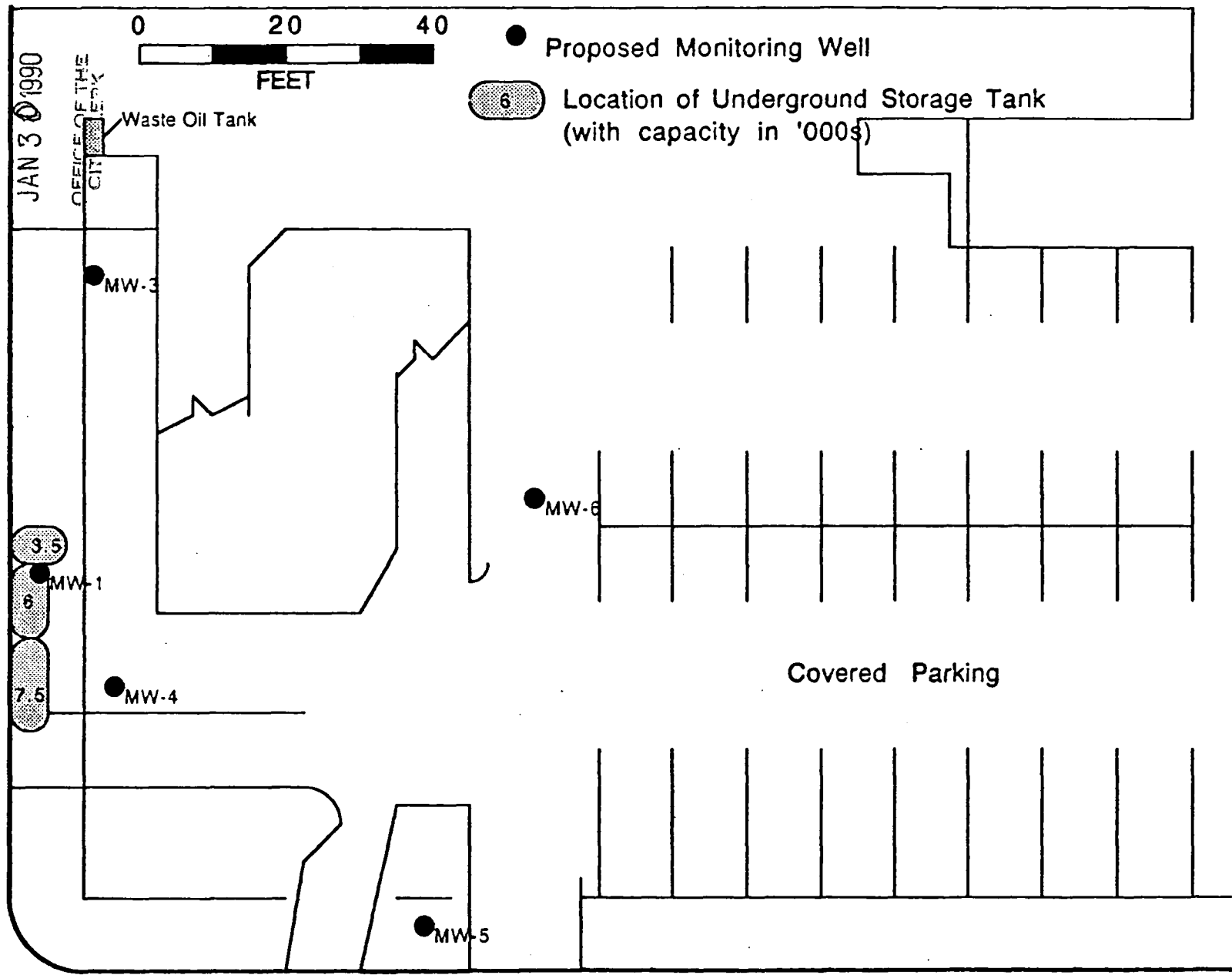
