Subject: Construction of Curbs at Bahnfleth and Reichmuth Parks (LA11/LA21) -  
Approval of Change Order 1 and Contract Completion

SUMMARY

Altman General Engineering Contractors and Civil Engineers of Yuba City has completed the above referenced project under Project LA11/LA21, Council Contract No. C086025, dated September 2, 1986. Change Order 1 is a balancing change order. The contract work including Change Order 1 was completed on December 19, 1986 at a total cost of \$22,824.01. Approval of Change Order 1 and acceptance of the contract is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project provided for the installation of curbs and relocation of sprinklers at Bahnfleth and Reichmuth Parks. Construction is now complete. The change order for \$592.01 increases the contract price to \$22,824.01.

FINANCIAL

Funds currently budgeted to this project are sufficient to cover the costs of construction.

It is recommended that the City Council:


1. Approve Change Order 1 in the amount of \$592.01.


