SUMMARY

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the above project. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND

On February 26, 1980, the City Council approved plans and specifications for N Street, 7th to 8th Street Utility Relocation and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 18, 1980. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL DATA

This project is in the amended 1979/80 budget for the Engineering Department, and the California Department of General Services, Office of the State Architect, has deposited with the City of Sacramento the sum of \$210,609.00 to cover the complete construction cost of the utility relocation work. The construction estimate for this project was \$202,650.00. The low bid of Mexica Construction is 21.39% below the construction estimate.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of Mexica Construction in the amount of \$159,303.00 be accepted.
