SUBJECT: Appeal of Rory Michael Loquet from the decision of the Department of Animal Control regarding two vicious dogs.

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Elizabeth A. MacDonald, attorney for Rory M. Loquet from the decision of the Department of Animal Control regarding two vicious dogs, as required by Section 6.101(b & c) of the Sacramento City Code.

BACKGROUND

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Department of Animal Control's budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council hereby determines pursuant to Section 2.324, City

Code, that this appeal will involve a lengthy factfinding process which will be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner". Therefore, the Council appoints John McLean as Hearing Examiner to hear the appeal on February 3, 1984 at the hour of 10:00 a.m. at McGeorge School of Law, 3287 Fifth Avenue, Sacramento, California.

- 2. If the Council should decide to consider the appeal itself, it is recommended that the hearing be set for January 31, 1984.



Dear Mr. Loquet:

Your two dogs, black and brown female Rottweilers, have been deemed vicious animals under the Sacramento City Animal Control Ordinance, section 6.101(b & c).

On November 27, 1983, your dogs, without provocation, attacked and bit a Mr. James Carter of 3201 - 33rd Street, Sacramento, CA. 95820.

On November 27, 1983, your two black and brown female Rottweilers, without provocation, enter the backyard of Mr. Rodney Andrews of 4441 - 8th Avenue, Sacramento, CA. 95820, and maliciously killed his dog (a 12-weeks old, black and tan female German Shepherd pup).

You are hereby notified that your two animals will be put to sleep on December 23, 1983.

If, you would like to appeal this determination of the Chief of Animal Control, to a Hearing Officer, you must file a notice of such appeal with the City Clerk's office at 915 - I Street, Sacramento, CA., City Hall, room 203, before December 22, 1983.
