SUBJECT: Sutterville Road/SPRR Drain (PN:WA21) - Project Approval and Bid
Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The 36 inch storm drain crossing under Sutterville Road just west of the old Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way requires replacement to correct a drainage problem. The City has received an agreement and grant of easement from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation, the current owner of the railroad right-of-way, to replace the portion of the storm drain which lies within the railroad right-of-way.

This project was originally advertised for bids on May 21, 1987. Only one bid was received on June 9, 1987, which far exceeded the engineer's estimate. A survey of contractors indicated that the majority were busy with other jobs at the time. It is believed that sufficient time has passed and that more bids will be received this time.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on November 12, 1986. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$18,600.

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$36,000. The current budget is \$40,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from 1965 Flood and Drainage Funds.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on September 1, 1987.
