ORDINANCE NO. 93-026

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF APR 13 1993

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A MORATORIUM UPON APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE CLEAN INDOOR AIR AND HEALTH ACT ORDINANCE AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 37.22 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE, AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 37.22 of the Sacramento City Code, until November 1, 1993, the Sacramento Environmental Commission shall not accept any application for an exemption or modification to the provisions of Chapter 37 of the City Code.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The grounds for the emergency are the need to suspend applications for exemption while studies are performed to determine whether alternative technologies which have been proposed by applicants and approved by the Commission do in fact provide the equivalent protection from sidestream smoke, to review the EPA's report which places environmental tobacco smoke on the list of Class A carcinogens. If the ordinance does not take effect immediately, the resources of the Environmental Commission, Environmental Health Division staff, and the applicants may be wastefully employed.
