

ORDINANCE NO. 970, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 892, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 8 1940, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING COLD STORAGE BUSINESS WHERE FRESH, COOKED, OR CURED MEATS ARE STORED, HELD OR KEPT IN PRIVATE FOOD LOCKERS, OR OTHERWISE, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 885, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 20 1940.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 892, Fourth Series, passed November 8 1940, is hereby amended to read as follows:-


SECTION 2. Any person, firm, partnership, or corporation using the facilities of a food storage plant for the storage of meats as hereinabove in Section 1 of this ordinance provided, shall, at the time of making each deposit of such meats, fill out and file in the office of the food storage plant where same is deposited, on forms furnished by the Health Officer, an accurate record thereof, containing a description of each article with the date of such deposit.
