

RESOLUTION NO. 84-163

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING HENRY G. MATHENY

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Henry G. Matheny on the fifteenth day of February, 1984 at the age of fifty, in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Hank Matheny was a native of Los Angeles who became well-known in his adopted hometown of Sacramento as a popular community leader, generous patron of the arts and a barrister of colorful delivery and fearsome reputation; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to his work as senior partner in the law firm of Matheny, Poldmore and Sears, Hank gave much to this community in his spare time, serving as a Professor of Law in Lincoln Law School, as an arbitrator with the American Arbitration Association and as supporter of the Sacramento Ballet and Sacramento Symphony as well as many other fine groups; and,

WHEREAS, Hank could converse expertly on a wide variety of subjects from boxing to ballet, physics to Disney Cartoons, motorcycles to world history. Yet he was always interested in hearing other opinions and was a caring, if outspoken friend to many; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Henry G. Matheny, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Henry G. Matheny.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to Luise Matheny, bereaved wife, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
