SUMMARY

Attached is a tabulation of the sealed proposals (Bid #718) received by the City Clerk for furnishing the City of Sacramento aggregate base, Class 2, cutback mixture, asphaltic concrete and commercial mix asphaltic concrete, in accordance with specifications adopted by the City Council.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A multiple award is being recommended to insure material availability in the event of material shortages or emergency needs due to geographic locations. The majority of the required materials will be purchased primarily from the lowest responsible bidder, Teichert Aggregates. However, in the event the primary contractor is unable to supply material, or emergency needs are required due to the geographic location of the project, contracts are being awarded to: Granite Construction to provide for material shortages and Collet Asphalt Products to provide for emergency material needs when crews are working in the area north of American River and west of I-80.

FUNDING

Sufficient funding is available in FY 1984-85 Street Maintenance Budget for the projected requirements.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council authorize multiple awards to insure material availability and provide for emergency needs due to geographic location



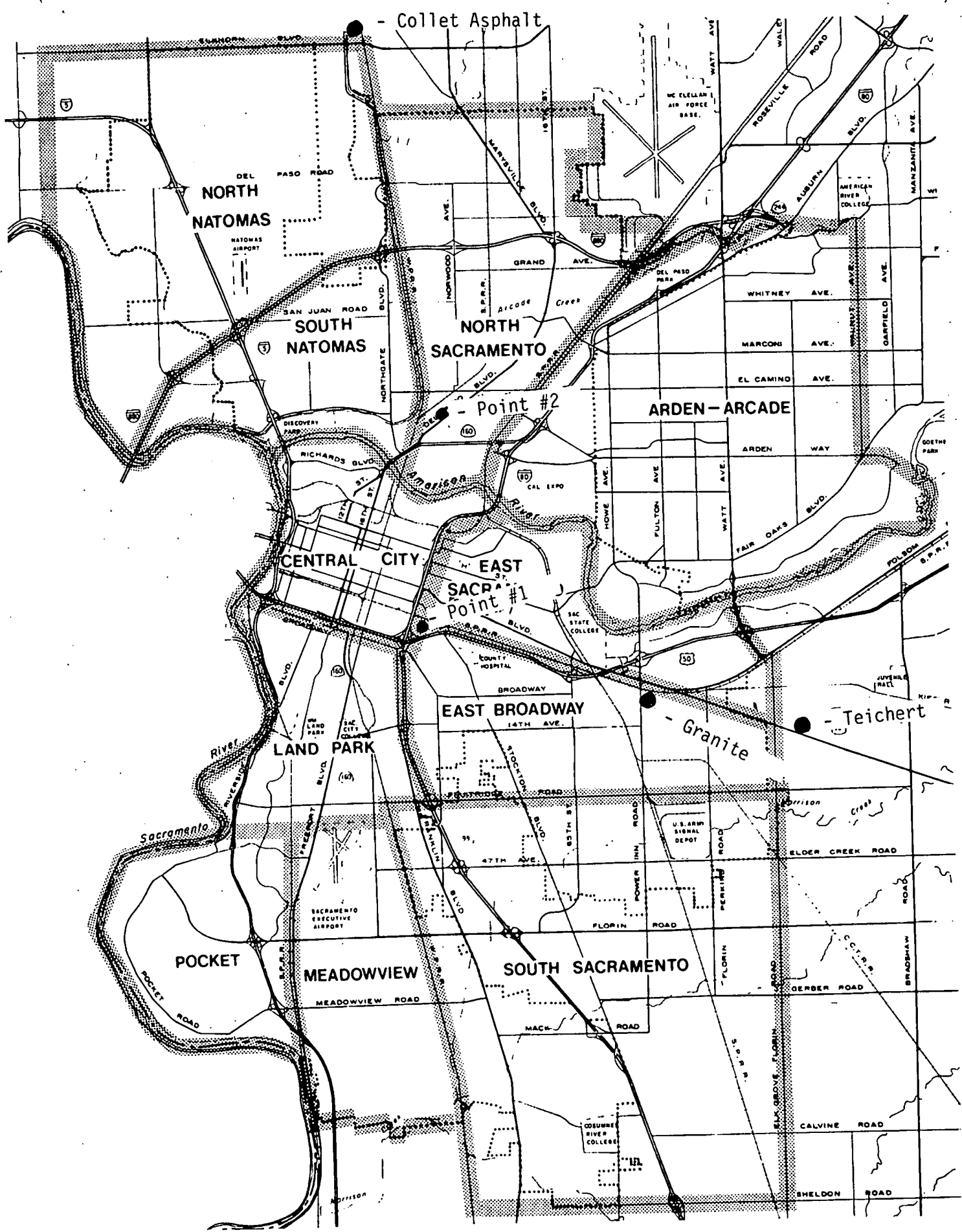
