SUBJECT: Parking Enforcement by Community Service Officers

SUMMARY

This is a request for approval of a Resolution to grant citation power to specified Community Service Officers (CSO's) employed by the Sacramento Police Department for the purpose of parking law enforcement.

This action is necessary to ensure a more timely response to parking complaints from areas outside the responsibility of the Parking Division.

BACKGROUND

On August 26, 1986, the City Council approved Resolutions to expand the abandoned vehicle and parking enforcement programs. As part of this program the Council agreed to empower the Police Department Community Service Officers to enforce parking regulations in those areas and time periods not covered by Parking Division (Public Works Department).

FINANCIAL DATA

The enhanced response to parking complaints will undoubtedly result in increased revenues received from citations, although the exact amount cannot be anticipated at this time. There will also be a salary savings by assigning Community Service Officers to these calls rather than full time police officers.

PURPOSES OF ENFORCING CERTAIN PROVISIONS
OF THE CITY CODE OR STATE LAW**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1

In order to enforce certain provisions of the City Code, those persons hereinafter named are hereby granted citation and arrest authority for the purpose of enforcing those particular provisions of the City Code hereinafter specified, and for those limited purposes only.
