ORDINANCE NO. 979 , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15 OF ORDINANCE NO. 976, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED FEBRUARY 19, 1943, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SAFETY TO LIFE IN PLACES OF ASSEMBLY," AND ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED 10.1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 15 of Ordinance No. 976, Fourth Series, passed February 19, 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15:

INSPECTION BY FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Chief of the Fire Department shall inspect or cause to be inspected, each place of assembly. Such inspection shall be at least monthly and at such times, including time of occupancy and use, as to assure compliance with these regulations and such orders as may be issued in connection with the maintenance of aisle space, the prevention of overcrowding, the use of decorations, the maintenance of exits, collapse of revolving doors, and the maintenance of fire appliances. Where conditions not specifically dovered by this order are found which are dangerous and constitute a hazard, the Chief of the Fire Department shall give written orders for an immediate correction thereof and neglect or refusal to comply shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.

Ordinance No. 976, Fourth Series, to be numbered 10.1:

Section 10.1

GENERAL LIGHTING.

In night clubs no person shall use, or permit to be used, an open flame for illumination or decorations and/or both.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that night clubs are about to install candles on tables which creates a dangerous situation.
