WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento requesting vacation of the public easements hereinafter described by changing the setback lines in certain lots in the subdivision known as Norwood Industrial Park.

WHEREAS, this City Council did fix the 9th day of June, 1981, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M., of said day in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place for hearing said petition and did give due notice thereof as required pursuant to Sections 50430 to 50445, inclusive, of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said vacation is declared after due proceedings had therefor according to law and the finding by the City Council which is hereby made, that said easements are unnecessary for present or prospective use.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BY IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the hereinafter described public easements in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and the same are hereby ordered vacated:

All that certain real property situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California and being portions of Lots 4 and 7 as said Lots are shown on the Plat of Norwood Industrial Park, and filed in Book 102 of Maps at Page 17, Sacramento County Records, said real property being strips of land 25 feet in width and lying within the line designated 25' S.B.L. on said map and the boundary lines of said Lots; said real property being more particularly described as follows:

### PARCEL 1

A strip of land 25 feet in width lying generally Southerly and Westerly of the following described line:
Beginning at the most Northerly corner of said Lot 7; thence from said Point of Beginning along the general Northerly and Easterly line of said Lot 7 the following courses: South 68° 22' 30" East 137.37 feet, from a tangent which bears South 21° 37' 30" West along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 30 feet and a central angle of 30° 59' 51", an arc distance of 16.23 feet (chord South 37° 07' 25" West 16.03 feet), tangent to the preceding curve along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 40 feet and a central angle of 241° 59' 42", an arc distance of 168.94 feet, tangent to the preceding curve along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 30 feet and a central angle of 30° 59' 51", an arc distance of 16.23 feet (chord North 06° 07' 35" East 16.03 feet), tangent to

the preceding curve along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 184.10 feet and a central angle of 12° 48' 40" an arc distance of 41.16 feet (chord North 28° 01' 50" East 41.08 feet); South 55° 33' 35" East 79.87 feet and South 1° 46' 30" East 155.42 feet to a point thereon, said strip of land being fully contiguous at its Westerly terminus to the general Westerly line of said Lot 7 and at its Southerly terminus to a line that bears South 79° 42' 30" West.

### PARCEL 2

A strip of land 25 feet in width lying Southerly of the following described line:
Beginning at the point of intersection of the general Easterly line of said Lot 7 with the Westerly line of Bollenbacher Avenue as shown on said map; thence from said Point of Beginning North 85° 01' 35" West 110.02 feet to an angle point in said Lot 7; said strip of land being fully contiguous at its Easterly terminus

to said Westerly line of Bollenbacher Avenue and at its Westerly terminus to a line that bears South 12° 16' 24" West.

### PARCEL 3

A strip of land 25 feet in width lying Northerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the Southeasterly corner of said Lot 7; thence from said Point of Beginning along the Southerly line of said Lot 7 South 89° 03' 30" West 160.00 feet to a point thereon; said strip of land being fully contiguous at its Easterly terminus to the general Easterly line of said Lot 7 and at its Westerly terminus to a line that bears North 12° 16' 24" East.

### PARCEL 4

A strip of land 25 feet in width lying Southerly, Westerly and Northerly of the following described line:
Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of said Lot 4, distant thereon South 89° 03' 30" West 105.00 feet from the Northeasterly corner thereof; thence from said Point of Beginning along the Northerly and general Easterly line of said Lot 4 the following courses: North 89° 03' 30" East 105.00 feet, South 0° 56' 30" East 100.00 feet, from a tangnet that bears South 89° 03' 30" West along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 30 feet and a

central angle of 59° 04' 40", an arc distance of 30.93 feet (chord North 61° 24' 10" West 29.58 feet); and tangent to the preceding curve along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 40 feet and a central angle of 114° 30' 37", an arc distance of 79.94 feet (chord North 89° 07' 08" West 67.29 feet), said strip of land being fully contiguous at its Northwesterly terminus to a line that bears South 0° 56' 30" East and at its Southwesterly terminus to a line that bears North 56° 22' 27" West.

This proposed abandonment has been undertaken due to the following facts:


- A request was presented to Council on May 19th,

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION



RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 5191

VACATING PUBLIC EASEMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 50430 TO 50445, INCLUSIVE, OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento has received a petition requesting the vacation of easements for light and air in the subdivision known as Norwood Industrial Park, said vacation to change the setback line in various lots of said Norwood Industrial Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said Council hereby declares its intention to vacate and aband the public easement, 25 feet in width, for light and air in the following described lots:
