## MINUTES:

Monika Hudson, Senior Administrative Services Officer - General Services, stated that at the request of Councilman Kastanis, staff had prepared a description of the work program and alternative for reducing the six year time line for completion of this project.

She stated that with the approved budget of \$25,000 and assuming that the same level of funding would be continued for this project, it would take approximately 6 years to complete the entire program. She stated that in order to reduce the time line, additional funding would have to be appropriated.

Ms. Hudson reported that the plan is to determine what areas are in the most need of painting in order to prioritize. She also stated that the first year of the project will be the painting of street light poles under 10 feet in height the second year will be the painting of poles over 10 feet in height and the third year will include painting of poles in signalized intersections.

Chair Robie asked that staff identify those areas where the 10 foot poles are located.

## MINUTES:

Steve Dee, Planning Department, gave an overview of the staff report. He reported that the draft EIR will access three scenarios for the 29th Street/Alhambra Boulevard Corridor Study Area. The three scenarios are 1) exisitng conditions, 2) zoning development potential, and 3) zoning development potential plus build out of 6 pending projects.

Mr. Dee stated that the EIR would provide necessary land use data to determine the building capacity of the corridor. He also informed the Committee that a Community Advisory Committee has been assembled to monitor the study. A draft EIR will be circulated to the Committee sometime in November for review and comments.
