ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PAINTING HOUSE
NUMBERS ON STREET CURBS AND DECLARING
SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY
ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

For a period of one hundred twenty (120) days after the effective date of this ordinance, the City Engineer or his designee shall not issue any permits for the painting of curbs (City Code §38.11).

SECTION 2.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY. The ground for the emergency is the need immediately to extend the ban on issuance of permits pursuant to City Code sections which do not adequately ensure protection of property owners from improper requests for compensation and poor quality work, which was enacted by the Council on September 23, 1987, because staff needs additional time to make recommendations on improving the permit procedure.


