**SUBJECT: Recommendation to Regulate Parking Time Limits on 20th
Street between Capitol Avenue and N Street**

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of a 2-hour time limit on 20th Street between Capitol Avenue and N Street.

BACKGROUND

Due to the heavy impact of all day parkers on 20th Street between Capitol Avenue and N Street, the merchants submitted a petition for two-hour limit parking. The petition submitted by the merchants represents 60% of the addressess in the block. A survey and study of on-street parking conditions in the area was conducted. Based on these results, it was determined that the area is eligible for a two-hour parking limit.


FINANCIAL DATA

No financial impact. Costs to implement, operate and maintain this small area can be absorbed into the existing budget.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution establishing a two-hour parking limit on 20th Street between Capitol Avenue and N Street be adopted.



**A RESOLUTION REGULATING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON
20TH STREET BETWEEN CAPITOL AVENUE AND N STREET**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets for a period of time longer than indicated on the signs:

2-hour zone between 8:00a.m. and 6:00p.m.
