

ORDINANCE NO. 983, FOURTH SERIES:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JULY, 1943; FIXING THE NUMBER OF OFFICES AND EMPLOYMENTS AND FIXING THE SALARIES THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1. The budget for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of July, 1943, as prepared and submitted to the Council as provided by the Charter, is approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. The offices and employments of the City and the salaries thereof for said fiscal year shall be as set out in said budget, which is hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure; said emergency being that the said budget should become effective on or before the beginning of said fiscal year.
