PROPOSED PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION CHARTER AMENDMENT

A lengthy discussion concerning the concept and the language of the proposed amendments to Articles VII and VIII of the City Charter was held. Board members were in agreement that existing Charter provisions concerning personnel administration should be modified, but that more time is needed for a thorough review of the issues and for input from the Civil Service Board, employee groups, et al.


The Board requested that a letter be drafted to request that the City Council suspend action regarding the proposed amendments to Articles VII and VIII of the City Charter because the majority of the Board members do not agree with the concept of the proposed amendments. The letter is to indicate that the Board is unanimous in its opposition to the language and to the Board's functions as set forth in the proposal.

It was also requested by President Wright to inquire of the City Attorney if, by redefining the word "reinstatement" to mean "reemployment", whether the problem of dual authority between City Council and Civil Service Board concerning the layoff and reinstatement problem could be alleviated.
