A Public Hearing is scheduled for this date pertaining to the proposed public improvement work in Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District, Improvement Proceeding No. 4947.

This public improvement proceeding has been undertaken due to the following facts:

- 1. A petition from the property owners was presented to Council on April 3rd, 1979.
- 2. That on April 1st, 1980, the City Engineer presented to the Council the Resolution of Intention for the project for approval.

  On that date, the Council did approve said Resolution, which set a Hearing date on the project for this date.
- 3. The project would consist of constructing storm drainage facilities in the proposed assessment district.

The purpose of the project is to construct the improvements in order to further develop the property.

- 4. No letters have been received by the City Clerk protesting the district.
