SUBJECT: Selection of a Consultant for a Granite Gravel Quarry EIR

SUMMARY

The Public Works Department recommends that the selection committee to determine a consultant to prepare the Granite Landfill EIR consist of 1) a city councilmember, 2) a County Public Works member, 3) a member of the City-County Solid Waste Advisory Committee, 4) a City Planning Department member, and 5) a member of the City Public Works staff.
