SUBJECT: LIBRARY SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION ACT GRANT

(\$140,900) TO FUND "THE READING CONNECTION"

PROJECT

SUMMARY

This is a request to accept \$140,900 from the Library Services and Construction Act, which has been approved for the above project by the California State Library.

BACKGROUND

In May 1988, the City Council approved that the Sacramento Public Library submit a grant application to the California State Library for \$160,828 to finance "The Reading Connection" project. That application, with some reduction in funding, has been approved by the State Library.

Funding will be used to establish links between the Martin Luther King Regional Library and seven Sacramento City Unified School District Elementary Schools, in order to increase library outreach to students in these schools and to their families.

The Sacramento Public Library is a coparticipant with the Sacramento City Unified School District in the project.

FINANCIAL DATA

The Grant amount of \$140,900 will be available to fund the project from October 1, 1988 through September 30, 1989. The \$140,900 will fund four new, limited-term, positions responsible for carrying out the project. In addition, the funding covers reading materials to be used with children served by the project; production of materials to promote activities and programs generated by the project; small equipment and expenses necessary to the operation of the project; and \$10,400 for indirect costs required in processing this grant award. (See Exhibit 1 for Budget Details.)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve this resolvtion to accept funding for "The Reading Connection."
