WHEREAS, Mike Hanamura will retire from the City of Sacramento on January 19, 2001, after 36 years of dedicated public service; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure in Sacramento, Mike Hanamura served as Chief of Housing Rehabilitation with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, Manager of the City of Sacramento's Neighborhood Improvement Program, and for the last six years Area Director for the City's Neighborhood Services Department; and
