SUBJECT: Appeal of Russ M. Farr dba Computer Identification Systems from the decision of the Sacramento Police Department regarding suspension of alarm permit.

### SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Russ M. Farr dba Computer Identification Systems from the decision of the Sacramento Police Department, as required by Section 29.9(a) of the Sacramento City Code.

### BACKGROUND

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

### FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Sacramento Police Department budget.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

1. If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council hereby determines pursuant to Section 2.324, City

- 2. If the Council should decide to consider the appeal itself, it is recommended that the hearing be set for January 29, 1985.


