MINUTES OF THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON MAY 18, 1994

Approval of Convention Center East Ballroom Panel Selection. The six finalists for apprentice were selected. Also, artist Steve Vanoni will be included as a finalist because his application was inadvertantly omitted from the panel packets. Committee recommended that Nancy call or write the East Ballroom Lobby panelists to inform them of the error and invite opinions on the matter. The apprentice finalists will be interviewed by the mentor, Nancy, and an APP designate in June. The mentor will then choose one female and one male as artist apprentices.

Richard Raisler mentioned that the artist selection panelists for the East Ballroom Lobby felt a need for 10 slides rather than three when viewing the mentor artists work. Some panel members were not familiar with the artists work, so they had to rely on sharing verbal knowledge to get a total picture. The panelists were satisfied with the selection.
