Agreement Covering Lowering and/or Raising Pacific Bell's Manholes by the City's Contractor on the Street Overlay 86-87

(Phase II) Contract (PN:RA91)



An agreement between Pacific Bell and the City of Sacramento to have the City's contractor lower and/or raise Pacific Bell's manholes during construction of the City's Street Overlay 86-87 (Phase II) contract has been reached. Pacific Bell will be billed for the work performed.

### BACKGROUND

In the past, contract delays have arisen because of coordination and scheduling difficulties encountered in the lowering and/or raising of existing utility manholes during construction of the City's Street Overlay Program. Specifically, streets which include pavement planing require lowering all manholes prior to the planing process and raising them after the overlay. To minimize these delays, the Engineering Division proposes to change the way utility coordination is handled for these projects.

Currently the utility companies are informed of the streets to be overlayed and the approximate timing of the project. The utilities then make arrangements to have their manholes lowered and/or raised. In order to better facilitate the contract operations it is desirable that the City's contract include the lowering and/or raising of the utility's manholes and the utility be billed for the work. Pacific Bell has agreed to this process. Other utilities agree to the principal, but were unable to participate in this contract.

#### FINANCIAL

The estimated cost for work covered by this agreement is \$13,000. The cost for this work will be paid by Pacific Bell. It is recommended that a fund appropriation be made as follows:

\$13,000 from the Capital Grant Fund (Fund #248) which will be reimbursed once Pacific Bell's funds are received.
