AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO APPLICATION FEES  
TO COVER ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS FOR PERMITS  
AND CLEARANCES ISSUED BY FIRE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

## SECTION 1.

Section 15.111 is hereby added to the Sacramento City Code to read as follows:


Sec. 15.111 Application fees for permits and clearances issued by the fire department.

The fire department shall charge fees to defray its administrative costs, including but not limited to inspections by fire department personnel, in connection with all applications for a permit or clearance, or annual renewal thereof, required under the Uniform Fire Code, the California Health and Safety Code, Title 19 of the California Administrative Code, or the Sacramento City Code. The fees shall be set by resolution of the City Council and shall be charged and collected at the time an application for a permit or clearance is made. The application fee shall not be refunded upon failure of an applicant to receive a permit or clearance or upon any revocation or suspension of a permit or clearance. No permit or clearance shall be valid until the required fee has been paid to the City Revenue Officer.
