SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE ALTA VALLEY WAY AND BRUCEVILLE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND RESURFACING PROJECT (PN:TM46)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Alta Valley Way and Bruceville Road. Council District 8.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the bid of American Engineering & Asphalt in the amount of \$226,298; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Alta Valley Way and Bruceville Road Reconstruction and Resurfacing Project.

SUMMARY:

This project will reconstruct deteriorated pavement and place an asphalt concrete overlay on Alta Valley Way between Mack Road and Bruceville Road and on Bruceville Road between Alta Valley Way and Valley Hi Drive.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate deteriorated streets and improve drainage in the area.

This project was advertised on May 15, 1996 and bids were received on June 19, 1996 as follows:

American Engineering & Asphalt did not meet the MBE/WBE goals, but did perform an acceptable good faith effort and is recommended for contract award.

Approval of the plans and specifications and award is recommended.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$199,762.

The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, construction and construction engineering costs, is \$296,000. The fund balance in the project is \$332,236 which is sufficient to award the contract.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section has reviewed the proposed Project. This review has resulted in the determination that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment. A Categorical Exemption was filed with the County Recorder on May 16, 1996.

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
POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Award of this contract is consistent with Title 58 of the Sacramento City Code.

MBE/WBE:

To encourage minority participation, plans and specifications were sent to 9 plan rooms and construction services organization. Four are directly involved with MBE/WBE construction firms. Staff recruited available MBE/WBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was announced on the City of Sacramento Project Information Line, which contains information on Public Works and Utility Department projects. Project notices were sent to 29 organizations involved in MBE/WBE recruitment.




