PHASE 1: Listen + Learn

PURPOSE: Introduce the project, gather values, goals, and mobility challenges.

Winter 2025

- **Public Workshop (1)** at community centers or affordable housing sites
- **Community Advisory Meeting (1)** with trusted community organizations and business partners
- **Pop-Up Listening Events (2)** at culturally relevant locations
- **Targeted Business/Property Owner Outreach (up to 2)**
- **Digital Survey** (multilingual, mobile-friendly)

PHASE 2: Design + Discuss

PURPOSE: Validate findings, share draft alternatives, and collect feedback.

Spring 2026
