SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division - Agreement for California Arts Council's State/Local Partnership Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Manager be authorized, by resolution, to execute the agreement between the City of Sacramento and the California Arts Council for \$25,388 for the 1984-85 State/Local Partnership Program.

BACKGROUND

Since 1980 the California Arts Council, through State legislation, has provided an annual block grant for local arts programming and planning.

The program required that all counties wishing to participate must designate a local partner to prepare and submit a local arts plan. The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, a city/county agency, was designated by the Board of Supervisors as the local partner. From 1980-1982 the Commission developed a local arts plan which included goals and objectives and a list of activities that would meet those objectives. The plan then was approved by the City Council and County Board of Supervisors and accepted by the California Arts Council. Since 1982 and each year thereafter, an annual report is submitted by the Arts Commission to the Board of Supervisors and California Arts Council for approval. This annual report summarizes how the objectives have been met and any changes that may have occurred. On September 28, 1984 the 1983-84 report was approved by the State. This approval allows for funding through the 1984-85 block and local priorities grant of \$25,388 to continue program planning and implementation of the stated objectives.

Funding for 1984-85 will provide partial salary support for the Arts Program Coordinator to continue to implement the program's objectives. The primary focus is on management of the Resource Center's library, publication of a bimonthly newsletter,

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coordinating a computerized telephone service and providing information and referrals to artists, arts organizations and the public.

FINANCIAL DATA

There is no additional cost to the City. The revenue associated with this grant will reimburse the General Fund for monies already approved and appropriated under the Metropolitan Arts Division's 1984-85 city budget.

RECOMMENDATION


