SUBJECT: Recreation Division - Authorization to Submit Grant Under the
County of Sacramento, Cultural and Civic Awards Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Recreation Division to submit a grant application to the County of Sacramento, Cultural and Civic Awards Program, in the amount of \$9,500 for the purpose of conducting an In-School Art Program for elementary school age children April 18, 1983 to April 17, 1984.

BACKGROUND

The Board of Supervisor for the County of Sacramento has allocated \$175,000 for the 1982-83 Cultural and Civic Awards Program. The monies are awarded to non-profit community based organizations or government entities that contribute to the quality of life in the Sacramento area. The In-School Art Program is a pilot project designed to provide elementary school age children the opportunity to participate in art workshops. The program will be conducted during school time hours and will include the study of art history and the fundamentals of painting and drawing. Application for Cultural and Civic Awards program funding for this project is appropriate.

FINANCIAL DATA

This project does not require additional City funds. The Recreation Division will provide in-kind support.
