Recognizing Sean Rooney and the Florin Road Partnership

WHEREAS, Sean Rooney has served as Executive Director of the Florin Road Partnership (a private property-based business improvement district with 160 property owners) since January 1996, managing every aspect of the Partnership including fiscal management of the \$275,000 budget, promotions, fundraising, government and community relations, business and economic development and event coordination; and

WHEREAS, in 1998 the Partnership created a non-profit charitable 501c(3) organization called the Florin Road Foundation to support and encourage the economic and social development of the Florin Road community; and

WHEREAS, staff has since dedicated over 200 hours to the Foundation's activities which include scholarships for local high school graduates, contributions to youth and senior organizations, grant applications and fund-raising activities, and has to date awarded three grants and five scholarships amounting to \$3,125; and

WHEREAS, the Partnership is also the recipient of numerous awards for a variety of programs, collaborations and projects, including the Community Services Planning Council, People Helping People Award; California State University, Sacramento, Business Partners in Education Award; the SWCC Meadowview Dedication to Service Award; and was selected by the City of Sacramento as a project for the All American City application; and


WHEREAS, the Partnership has also formed collaborations with over 30 organizations and is very active and involved with more than half a dozen neighborhood associations.






