Overview of the Expanded Railyards Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District (EIFD) and Draft Amended Infrastructure Financing Plan

Location (of project): Council District 3

Project Description: The proposed expansion of the Stadium Area EIFD (proposed to be renamed Railyards EIFD), which currently consists of 24 pancels comprising 42 acres among nine existing property owners, to a total of 244-acres within the Railyards specific plan area. Although a significant number of improvements have been completed in the Railyards, project development still faces an extraordinary infrastructure funding burden. Therefore, to support development in the Railyards as a whole, the following amendments to the EIFD will be proposed.

- EiFD Boundary Expansion Encompassing the complete Railyards Specific Plan Area
- EIFD Name Change The Stadium Area EIFD will be renamed to Railyards EIFD which reflects the expanded boundaries and broader infrastructure funding.
- Amend the infrastructure Finance Plan (iFP) Due to the proposed expansion of the EiFD, amendments to the existing iFP are necessary to accommodate the additional infrastructure and public facilities that will be incorporated within the EiFD.

The EIFD allows incremental properly tax revenue from the City within the boundary of the EiFD to be used to finance public facilities and other specified projects of community, wide significance that provide significant benefits to the EiFD and the surrounding community. The proposed boundaries of the expanded EiFD are shown on the map ettached hereto as Exhibit A. A complete list of the public facilities and development proposed to be financed is included in the draft infrastructure Finance Plan, which is available for viewing at http://www.cityofsacramento.org/Finance/Public-Improvement-Financing/Documents

Pursuant to the EIFD Law, the PFA is to hold this public meeting, at which PFA staff will present a draft-IFP, answer questions about the IFP, and consider comments about the IFP.

Environmental Determination: This notice regarding a public meeting is a notice regarding a financing, organizational and administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. A subsequent resolution establishing the EiFD amendments and other actions, including review under CEQA, are required prior to any proposed physical changes. Thus, the holding of this public meeting does not constitute a project and is not subject to CEQA review. CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b) (4) & (5); 15080(c)(3).


