

ORDINANCE NO. 641, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 22, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1ST, 1921". BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED 60-a.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed September 22, 1921, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 60-a.

SECTION 60-a.

PRINTING

For every person, firm or corporation soliciting or taking orders for typesetting, job printing or binding, the sum of \$50.00 per quarter.


For every person, firm or corporation conducting, managing or carrying on the business of typesetting, job printing or binding in the City of Sacramento and Sacramento Metropolitan Area, where the plant of said licensee is located in said Area, the sum of \$3.00 per quarter.

Provided, that no additional license or fee for soliciting shall be required of any person, firm or corporation, or employee of same, who holds a license to operate such job printing, typesetting or binding business, and which is to be printed in the shops of the licensee.


"Metropolitan Area" of Sacramento, for the purposes of this ordinance is hereby defined to be that territory described as Metropolitan Area in 1930 Census.
