SUBJECT: 1990-91 Street Overlay - Measure A (One Half Cent Sales Tax)
Program - Phase I (PN:RC61) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is a continuation of the annual program to overlay deteriorating streets in the City of Sacramento to forestall the necessity to reconstruct the street surface. The project includes key cutting, pavement planing, adjustment of valve boxes and utility accesses to grade, placing asphaltic overlay blanket, and replacement of existing vehicle detector loops that are damaged or inoperative. The streets to be overlaid are:

- Mack Road - Franklin Boulevard to Morrison Creek
- Folsom Boulevard - Alhambra Boulevard to 48th Street
- Alhambra Boulevard - B Street to U.S. Hwy 50 Overpass
- Eleanor Avenue - Traction Avenue to Del Paso Boulevard
- South Land Park Drive - Florin Road to 14th Street
- South Land Park Drive - 13th Street to 35th Avenue
- South Land Park Drive - 14th Street to 13th Street

On June 26, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on July 24, 1990. The bids received were:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$870,000. The estimated project completion date is November 15, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$943,000. The current budget is \$3,445,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Sales Tax funds (201). The funds available for this project amount to \$3,445,000, as of July 24, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City code governing award of contracts.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were fourteen (14) planholders for this project, none of whom are listed as certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Teichert Construction in the amount of \$791,490.50 and award the contract.


