**SUBJECT: FLORIN PERKINS ROAD AND 23RD AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Florin Perkins Road and 23rd Avenue – Council 6. (See location map, Attachment A).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution:

- Approving the plans and specifications for the Florin Perkins Road and 23rd Avenue Traffic Signal Project (PN: SM08);
- Accepting the bid and awarding the construction contract to Pacific Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$139,645, and
- Authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute a contract in the amount of \$139,645 with Pacific Excavation, Inc.

SUMMARY:

This project involves the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Florin Perkins Road and 23rd Avenue. In addition, new curb ramps, signing and pavement markings, and interconnect will be installed at this intersection. This report recommends that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and award the construction contract to Pacific

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Florin Perkins Road and 23rd Avenue intersection currently does not have a traffic signal. Funding was appropriated to the project during the 2002 fiscal year. The installation of the signal will enhance the movement of traffic and provide a safe crossing for pedestrians.

This project was advertised and bids were received on February 23, 2005. The results are summarized below.

Contractor	Total BID	ESBE Participation Goal 20%
Pacific Excavation Inc.	\$139,645	100%
Richard Heaps Electric	\$150,724	20.4%
Tennyson Electric	\$175,906	6.0%

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$180,000. It is recommended that the contract be awarded to Pacific Excavation Inc.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The current total project budget is \$394,410. As of February 23, 2005, the Florin Perkins Road and 23rd Avenue Project (PN: SM08) has an unobligated balance of \$332,665, which is sufficient to execute the contract in the amount of \$139,645 with Pacific Excavation, Inc.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Development Services Department, Environmental Planning Section has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301 (a) and Class 2, Section 15302 (c), and Class 3, Section 15303 (d). Projects exempted under Classes 1, 2 and 3 consist of the operation maintenance and repair of existing facilities, replacement and reconstruction of existing structures and the construction of limited numbers of new, small facilities. A Notice of Exemption has been prepared and will be filed with the County Recorder's office.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3. This report is consistent with the Sacramento City Strategic Plan goal to improve the transportation system and enhance and preserve neighborhoods.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was also announced on the City's Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids. The recommended contractor is a certified Small Business Enterprise and has committed to 100% E/SBE participation on the project.

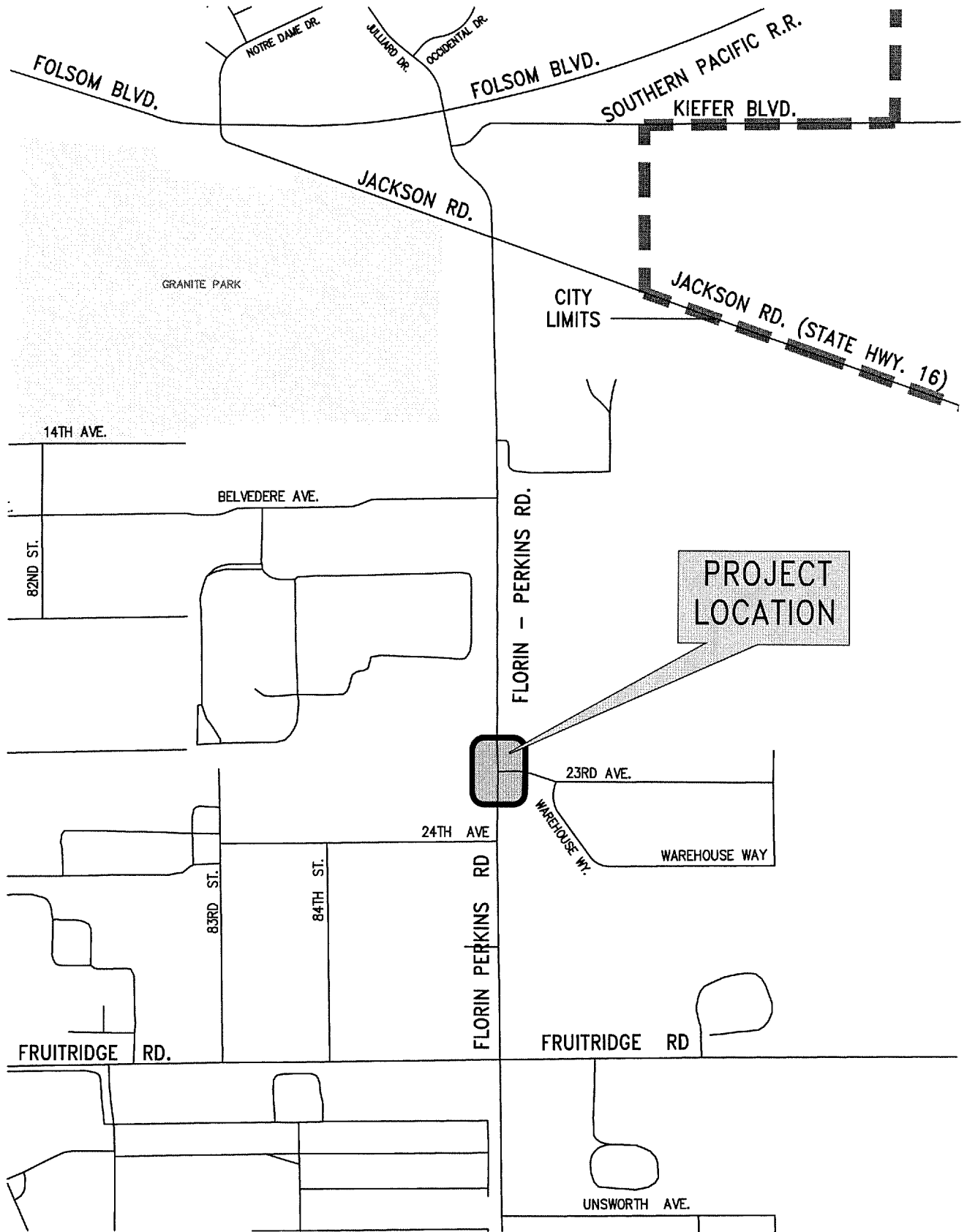

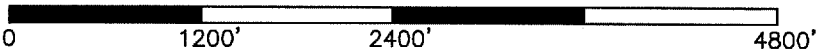
