SUBJECT:

Resolution Appropriating Funds for the Extension of a Storm Drain Line Between Harvard and Manning Streets on Silica

Avenue

SUMMARY:

On May 4, 1980 the City Council approved funding for the subject project. However, funds were not to be appropriated until a bill for the City's share of the project was received. The City has received a bill for the work performed, therefore, it is now necessary to appropriate \$14,325.00 to the subject project.

FINANCIAL:

Funds are available in the unappropriated Sewer Fund Balance.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that \$14,325.00 be appropriated from the Sewer Fund Balance to the City Engineer's Budget by passage of the attached resolution.

RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980/81 FOR THE EXTENSION OF A STORM DRAIN LINE BETWEEN HARVARD AND MANNING STREETS ON SILICA AVENUE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. An appropriation of \$14,325.00 is necessary to pay the City's share of the extension of a storm drain line between Harvard and Manning Streets on Silica Avenue.
- 2. The City Budget for Fiscal Year 1980/81 is hereby amended by appropriating \$14,325.00 from the unappropriated fund balance of the Sewer Fund (4-14) to the City Engineer's Budget (4-14-2600-2713-4820) for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.
