SUBJECT: FIRE STATION #13 DRIVEWAY--ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAPITAL PROJECT FOR DRIVEWAY REPAIR AND APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR REPAIR OF STATION #13 DRIVEWAY

SUMMARY:

The Facility Development Section has coordinated the preparation of plans and specifications for the emergency repair of the Fire Station #13 Driveway. This report recommends establishment of a capital project for fire station driveway repair and approval of the plans and specifications for the Station #13 Driveway.

BACKGROUND:

Use of heavier trucks and a very wet winter last year have caused deterioration of the driveway pavement at Fire Station 13, necessitating removal and replacement of the driveway. The subgrade soil has failed, and in its present state the driveway will not last through the winter.

FINANCIAL:

By the attached resolution request the renaming of capital project FA11 to Fire Station Driveway Repair. It is currently named Ramp Repair, Station #10. The driveway of Station #13 is in more urgent need of replacement than the driveway of Station #10.

The architect's estimate for the total Fire Station #13 Driveway Repair project is \$18,300, with an estimated construction cost of \$16,700. The \$12,300 currently in capital project FA11 will be augmented by \$6,000 transferred from operating funds. No new funding is required.




It is recommended that the following actions be approved by Council:
