SUBJECT: 65th Street Expressway Traffic Signal Coordination
(PN:SB76) - Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will interconnect the traffic signals along 65th Street from Folsom Boulevard to Elder Creek Road to improve the flow of traffic along that arterial. The pedestrian walk lights will be modified to improve pedestrian safety at the intersections.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on October 5, 1989. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$161,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds will be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction cost, is \$209,500. The current budget is \$150,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds (209). The funds currently available for this project amounts to \$120,000 as of November 14, 1989. It is proposed that the final budgetary recommendation be made following receipt of bids.

A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover the cost of reproduction.
