## SUMMARY

This report recommends a 12.5% user rate increase for the Camp Sacramento enterprise effective February 16, 1982.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

During the 1980 budget hearings, the City Council directed the staff to recommend a 1981 fee structure to provide adequate revenue to convert Camp Sacramento to a full enterprise operation similar to the Boat Harbor enterprise. In February 1981, the Budget and Finance Committee recommended and the Council approved a staged, two-season increase of 12.5% in March of 1981 and 12.5% in March, 1982 to accomplish the full enterprise operation. The two-part user fee increase has the endorsement of the Friends of Camp Sacramento.

Staff is now recommending the second of the user fee increases be adopted for the 1982 season. This increase will generate enough revenue to make Camp Sacramento a totally self-supporting facility.

## FINANCIAL DATA

The proposed 12.5% fee increase will generate approximately \$27,820 in additional revenue during the 1982 season, making Camp Sacramento a full enterprise operation. A comparative rate schedule is provided as follows:
