SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT
REFLECTING CHANGE FROM BI-WEEKLY SALARY TO HOURLY SALARY
FOR DELIVERY DRIVER FRED HARTLEY

SUMMARY:

The City-County Librarian requests approval by the City Council of the execution of agreement between the City of Sacramento acting on behalf of the Mountain-Valley Library System, and Fred Hartley, currently providing services to the Mountain-Valley Library System, said agreement reflecting a change in the delivery schedule made by the MVLS Executive Council.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Mountain-Valley Library System (MVLS) is a consortium of independent city, county, college, university and special libraries who have joined to form a cooperative network, providing interlibrary loans, reference backup and delivery services for a nine-county area in the state of California.

Following review of delivery routes, fuel costs and budgetary constraints, the route driven by Fred Hartley was reduced from 40 to 32 hours weekly by the Executive Council of the Mountain-Valley Library System. The agreement should be amended to reflect the change from bi-weekly to hourly status.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The City of Sacramento, as fiscal agent for the Mountain-Valley Library System, expends MVLS funds received pursuant to standard agreements between the State Department of Education, the State Library and the City of Sacramento; there is no obligation on the part of the City of Sacramento or MVLS to continue personnel employed with project funds after these funds have been expended. This MVLS employee is not in any jurisdiction's civil service system. As the contract stipulates, this employee is not an employee of either the City of Sacramento, or the individual participating libraries in the cooperative library system.

Also as stipulated in the contract, the System, from System funds, pays social security, workers' compensation and medical and dental benefits. No retirement benefit is offered to MVLS employees, other than Social Security. No city funds are used for any payment to any MVLS employee. The MVLS pays the entire cost from its funds. The System also pays a fiscal agent fee to the City (\$12,205 in FY 1980/81) to enable the City to recover the costs of expending MVLS funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is therefore recommended that your Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the execution of the agreement between the City of Sacramento, acting on behalf of the Mountain-Valley Library System, and Fred Hartley, currently providing services as System Driver to the Mountain-Valley Library System.
