The Engineer's estimate was \$50,000.00.

#### BACKGROUND

The North Sacramento area's water system has been substandard since the City has taken over operation and maintenance. In order to provide better

water pressures for fire protection this large diameter distribution main is needed.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

This project was budgeted in the 1977/78 fiscal year budget for the Division of Water & Sewers for \$35,000.00 of which \$32,641.70 remains. Therefore, an amendment to this budget will be necessary to cover the amount of the lowest responsive bid (\$41,999.00). \$9,400.00 will be transferred from Water Fund (4-13) to Water Distribution Capital Improvement, 4-13-3030-1572-4820. #### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the low bid of Murphy Construction Co.(\$41,999.00) be accepted and that a resolution be passed amending the budget.
