water pressures for fire protection this large diameter distribution main is needed.


FINANCIAL DATA

This project was budgeted in the 1977/78 fiscal year budget for the Division of Water & Sewers for \$35,000.00 of which \$32,641.70 remains. Therefore, an amendment to this budget will be necessary to cover the amount of the lowest responsive bid (\$41,999.00). \$9,400.00 will be transferred from Water Fund (4-13) to Water Distribution Capital Improvement, 4-13-3030-1572-4820. It is recommended that the low bid of Murphy Construction Co. (\$41,999.00) be accepted and that a resolution be passed amending the budget.


