SUBJECT: Playfield Modifications at Del Paso Heights School (PN:LA51) - Bid Rejection

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and rejection of those bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project was planned to regrade a portion of the playfield at Del Paso Heights School to correct an erosion problem. Following a rain storm or irrigation, water running off the playfield erodes the dirt onto the sidewalk and street area.

On September 2, 1986 the City Council approved plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on September 30, 1986. The bids received were:

P.J.C. Landscaping	\$16,642.00
Leo Landscape Construction	\$18,248.60
B and V Landscaping, Inc.	\$18,791.00
Celik Engineering	\$24,640.00

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$16,000.

The low bidder, P.J.C. Landscaping, did not submit any information on subcontracting, neighborhood hiring, or any efforts to meet the "Good Faith Requirement" to meet the goals. The second bidder, Leo Landscape Construction, achieved the goal for Women's Business Enterprise (WBE) utilization, but failed to meet the goal for Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) utilization, and did not submit sufficient documentation to demonstrate a good faith effort to meet that goal, or to meet the neighborhood hiring goal. The third bidder, B and V

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Playfield Modifications at Del Paso Heights School
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Landscaping, Inc., is an MBE, but failed to submit any information concerning the good faith effort to obtain subcontracts with WBE's or other MBE's, or evidence of a good faith effort toward the neighborhood hiring goal. The high bidder, Celik Engineering, met the goal for neighborhood hiring, but failed to reach the goals for MBE and WBE utilization, and did not submit any documentation to demonstrate a good faith effort to reach those goals.


FINANCIAL

The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, was \$19,800. The current budget is \$20,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Community Development Block Grant Funds.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the bids received on September 30, 1986 be rejected, and that the project be readvertised for bids in the near future.
